Athol Murray College of Notre Dame
\$ 12,500

Maier Acceleration Centre Revitalization Project
- to upgrade existing equipment and purchase new equipment in the gym and weight rooms to better meet the fitness and conditioning needs of students, staff and community members who use the centre.

Greater Bragg Creek Trails Association
\$ 26,100

West Bragg Creek Trail Construction
- to begin construction of non-motorized recreational trails in West Bragg Creek for hiking, mountain biking, horse-back riding, cross country skiing and snow shoeing as per the approved West Bragg Creek All Season Trails Plan in partnership with Alberta Tourism, Recreation and Parks.

Hull Child & Family Services
\$ 7,000

Hull School Ice Hockey Program
- to provide all ages of Hull students with fundamental hockey skills instruction, knowledge of the game and the use of equipment with the goal of building self confidence through a positive learning experience.

Hockey Hall of Fame and Museum
\$100,000 per year (over a ten year period)

*D.K. (Doc) Seaman Hockey Resource Centre Sustainability Project**
- to provide stable funding over ten years to enhance the D.K. Seaman Hockey Resource Centre's acquisition, archiving and exhibition of its collection. This centre is housed in the new 18,000 square foot, state of the art archive, research and development facility within a 4-pad arena complex in the Lakeshore West District of Toronto.

KidSport Canada
\$ 50,000

Canadian Skate Shack Project
- to construct a mobile 30' trailer and stock it with 400 pairs of skates and helmets to make skating accessible to ALL families (including families facing financial hardships and new Canadian families) through this FREE service to community groups. This grant represents support for the Calgary portion of the project as one of eight cities where this project is planned.

Northern Alberta Institute of Technology (NAIT)
\$ 20,000

2011 NAIT Athletics Summer Hockey Camp
- to provide free hockey camps for 40 underprivileged and at-risk youth in 2011 and 2012. The camps, designed for children aged 4 to 16 will include a variety of small group sessions, exercises, games and scrimmages to improve all aspects of skill development as well as foster pride and self worth.

Silver Springs Community Association
\$ 9,500

Storage Shed for Outdoor Rink Equipment
- to build a heated storage shed to house rink operating equipment to maintain four outdoor rinks.

University of Lethbridge
\$ 6,900

Women's Hockey Dressing Room Enhancements
- to create the interior enhancements required for the Pronghorn Women's hockey program in the dressing room being added to the Nicholas Sheran Arena.

Varsity Community Association
\$ 18,000

Ice Resurface and Garage Modifications
- to purchase a used Zamboni-like ice resurfer and make modifications to an existing garage in order to store the machine.
