### **Alberta Theatre Projects**

**\$ 25,000**

*Playing With Fire: The Theo Fleury Story*

- to support two unique production elements (synthetic ice and projection equipment) enabling the stage adaptation of Theo Fleury's best-selling memoirs through a bold and honest one-man show. ATP will be partnering with KidsUp Front to provide tickets to youth.

### **Athol Murray College of Notre Dame**

**\$ 12,500**

*Maier Acceleration Centre Revitalization Project*

- to continue the upgrade of existing equipment and purchase new equipment in the gym and weight rooms to better meet the fitness and conditioning needs of students, staff and community members who use the centre.

### **Hockey Canada / Canadian Hockey Association**

**\$ 162,000**

*Hockey Canada "Ed Chynoweth" Internship Program*

- to support the Ed Chynoweth Internship program for a three year period. Five internships will be awarded annually to outstanding college graduates who are pursuing careers in sport administration, sport management or sport development. These 8-month term positions will be located in hockey operations at Hockey Canada national office in Calgary, and three league offices in Calgary, Toronto and Montreal.

### **City of Calgary – Calgary Police Service**

**\$ 11,400**

*Hockey Calgary / Calgary Police Service Power Play Program*

- support the Power Play Program for youth ages 10 – 17 who face cultural or financial barriers to playing hockey; also includes youth at risk.

### **Spray Lake Sawmills Recreation Park Society**

**\$ 25,000**

*Hockey access for at-risk youth*

- to support the provision of subsidies, equipment and ice time for at-risk youth and those facing financial barriers.

### **Village of Longview / Longview ARC Society**

**\$ 35,000**

*Longview 'Xtreme Makeover' Phase 2 Rink Upgrade*

- to assist with making the outdoor rink a multi season/multi use recreational area with inclusion of a concrete pad, basketball and tennis nets and skate park equipment which all extend the use of rink to year round.
